## A WILD AND WONDERFUL WINTERLAND


The absolutely best way to experience the coast of Norwegian Lapland is from the deck of one of the Hurtigruten ships. Shore excursions include a trip to the North Cape – Europe’s northernmost point, snowmobile or dog-sledge trips. During the winter, the light north of the Polar Circle is at its most beautiful. The sight of the Northern Lights dancing over the sky will stay with you forever. But the Arctic light is so much more than the Northern Lights. The darkness and dark season allow the full palette of natural light to shine. A journey onboard the Hurtigruten is also a culinary delight, with the menu changing in harmony with the areas we sail past.
